June 5-9



How Does My Garden Grow! – Get ready to make learning about gardens, flowers, vegetables and the principles of horticultural an enjoyable experience. The children will discover what a plant is, what plants need, and why we need plants. Our students will decorate their own garden tile or pot to take home.

June 12-16



Zoo Crew – The children will learn characteristics and facts about a different zoo animal every day. We will share the importance of humans respecting animals, their homes and habits. We have requested the “Zoo to You” Bio Park Outreach Program to visit us on Friday, June 16, at 10:00 a.m.

June 26-30



Cuisine for Children – During this scrumptious camp the students will create a healthy and tasty snack each day. The children will learn basic cooking vocabulary, techniques, measurements, kitchen safety and the importance of following directions (recipes). We will talk about eating healthy and taking care of our bodies. The students will create a recipe book to share with their families.

July 3-7



The Sun, my favorite star! The students will learn sun facts and sun safety during this four day camp. Our friends will create a collage, decorate a hat/visor, create sun art and discover shadows. On Friday the children will make sweet homemade lemonade to sip and taste for snack time.

July 10-14



Bill Martin, Jr (1916-2004) - We will focus on books written by one of America’s favorite children’s author, Mr. Bill Martin, Jr. He wrote more than 300 books, among them the bestselling classics *Brown Bear, Brown Bear, What do you see?*, and *Chicka Chicka Boom Boom*. Bill Martin, Jr was gifted in his ability to speak directly to children through his “jazzy” writings. In promoting literacy development the teachers will read a book and then offer the children a fun activity based on the book of the day.

July 17-21



Art-mania – Please send your child with appropriate clothing for a full day of messiness. The teachers will introduce and provide many different tools and mediums to encourage the students to embrace their inner artist. This child-centered art camp will offer activities that involve self-expression. At the end of the week we will display some of the children’s art creations in the Son Shine Café for everyone to appreciate.

July 24-28



Marine Science – The ocean is often said to be Earth’s last great frontier. An estimated 85% of the world’s ocean remains unexplored. Throughout this camp the children will discover facts about the deep blue sea as well as explore different sea creatures that loom on the bottom of the ocean. Some of these animals include the giant spider crab, and a new species that was discovered in 2016 called the Mariana Trench jellyfish.
